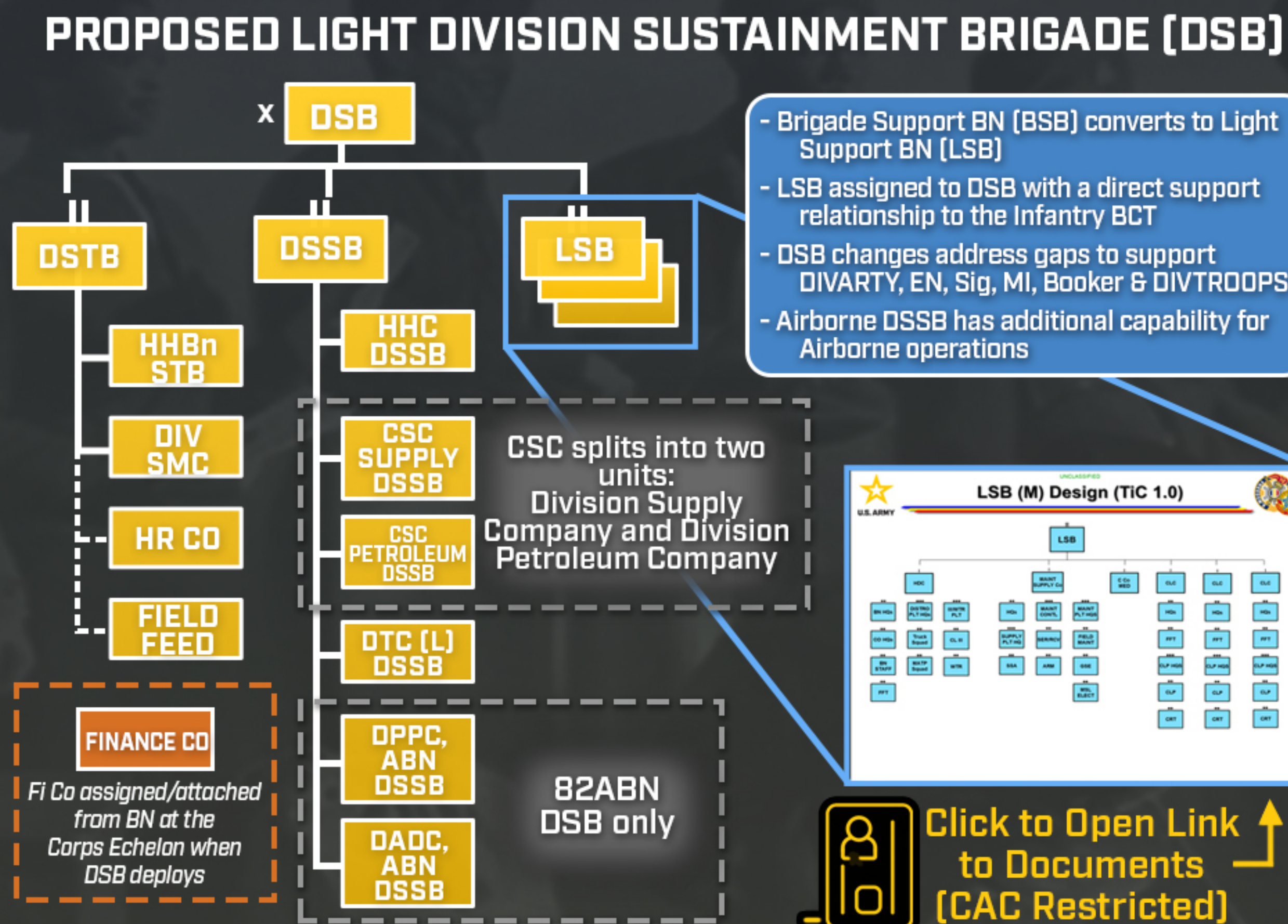

IMPACT:

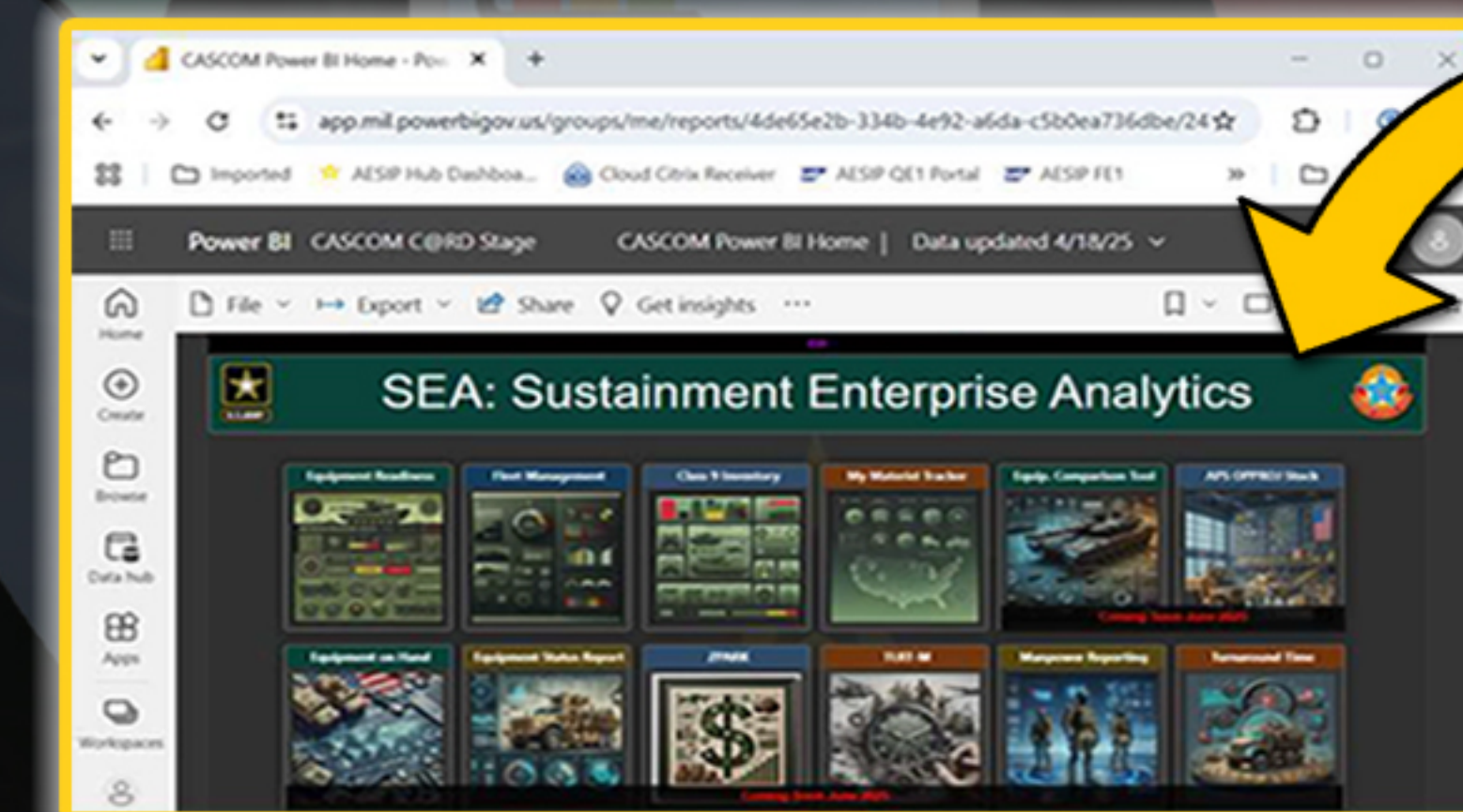
Existing C@RD users will see a new link in the GCSS-Army Portal for "SEA" under the "Home" tab
