SUBJECT: U.S. Army Combined Arms Support Command and Fort Lee Policy Letter - Risk Decision

1. References:

- a. AR 385-10, The Army Safety Program, 24 February 2017.
- b. DA Pam 385-30, Risk Management, 2 December 2014.

2. Risk management is our most effective tool to protect the force by providing a systematic framework for identifying and controlling risks in all environments and operations. Commanders are responsible for managing risk to ensure potential benefit outweighs the potential loss.

3. Risk decisions will be based on the residual risk of an activity after applying appropriate control measures. Risk decision authority is as follows:

- a. Extremely High Risk - Senior Commander and General Officer (GO) Commandants/Commanders.
- b. High Risk - Commanders, Commandants or Heads of Separate Organizations (Colonel/O-6) or equivalent in the appropriate Chain of Command.
- c. Medium Risk - Lieutenant Colonels (Battalion Commanders/Department Directors) or equivalent in the appropriate Chain of Command.
- d. Low Risk - Company Commanders or Division Chiefs or equivalent in the appropriate Chain of Command.

4. This document supersedes Risk Decision Policy dated 26 October 2018.

5. This policy is effective until superseded or rescinded.
